What is child labour?

It is clear that not all forms of work that children perform can be called "child labour". It depends on the child's age and on the type of work performed, under which conditions it is performed and what the objectives are. The term "child labour" is usually referred to the work that harms children and prevents them from attending school. Children who work full-time do not receive any education, have little or no time to play. According to the International Labour Organization, about 215 million children between the ages of 5 and 17 currently work under illegal, dangerous and exploitative conditions. They work because of the poverty of their families, who are not able to provide for them. A high percentage of children work in commercial agriculture, fishing, manufacturing, mining, and domestic service. Unfortunately, many children also work in illicit activities like the drug trade.
